First call for abstracts for the 2023 ICOPE Conference

ICOPE is the premier international conference for Psychology educators in Universities, Colleges and High Schools to present their research (especially evidenced-based educational innovations) and to discover new and interesting concepts in Psychology learning and teaching. The ICOPE Organising Committee liaises with national and international societies in developing its program for the conference. The [Society for the Teaching of Psychology](#) is a co-sponsor.

The 2023 ICOPE Conference will be held in **Mexicali, Mexico, from October 27-28, 2023 at Universidad Autonoma De Baja California (UABC).**

The conference theme is:

“Tuning Psychology Education to Serve Humanity and Habitat”.

The program will consist of posters and talks (some grouped in symposia), presented live to an audience and shared online via Zoom, or presented exclusively online via Zoom.

Suggested topics include:

- Conference Theme: Tuning Psychology Education to Serve Humanity and Habitat
- Rethinking/revolutionising undergraduate psychology education
- International collaborations in psychology educations: Challenges and opportunities
- Utilising technology to optimise and progress psychology education
- Psychology education and social justice
- Reconsidering roles for academics/faculty
- Accreditation and credentialing of degree programs
- Work-integrated learning and employability for graduates
- Developing students' professional identity
- Competency-based assessment
- Culture and diversity
- International opportunities (for students, and for mobility)
- Purpose of the research PhD
- and other relevant topics

Submission requirements:

Individual talk/paper: Abstracts should be no more than 200 words and proposals will be evaluated based on their relevance to the conference theme, innovation, evidence base, and anticipated interest/value to conference attendees. Please use the google form (link below) for completing your abstract. Following review of all abstracts, it may be that some individual talk submissions will be assigned as poster presentations.

Symposia: The Chair of the symposium should submit one proposal which includes all abstracts for the symposium. Please complete the google form, link below with details for the chair of the symposium and upload a file which includes the abstract for the symposium followed by the titles, authors, affiliations and abstract for between 3 and 4 numbered talks which form the symposium. Symposia will be reviewed based on the same criteria as individual talks and posters.

Posters: The requirements for poster abstracts are the same as that for individual talks. Note that if your abstract is accepted, you will be provided with the formatting/presentation requirements for the poster. Please use the Google form (link below) for completing your abstract.

All submissions must be in **English** or **Spanish**, and submitted via this Google form: <https://tinyurl.com/icope2023-submissions>

Important dates:

- Deadline for abstracts - 30 April, 2023.
- Notification of acceptance – 31 May 2023.
- Registrations open – 31 May 2023.

Important Notes:

1. If a future pandemic or similar incident occurs, such that 'live' presentations at the conference venue are no longer possible, then the conference will transition to entirely online. There is no registration fee, but **registrants need to be responsible** for all of their costs/expenses, including insurance of their travel if they intend to attend the conference physically in Mexicali. ICOPE and UABC are not responsible for any associated costs.

2. Regardless of whether the conference is blended or entirely online, the Scientific Committee *may* (a) ask all accepted online presenters to produce a video of their talk, and (b) expect presenters to be 'present' and responding through the online Chat of their presentation.
