<u>Position #1</u> — Open rank faculty member to teach in the CACREP-accredited Clinical Mental Health Counseling (CMHC) graduate program. Qualified candidates must have an earned doctoral degree in counselor education (CACREP-accredited program graduates preferred) and be eligible for licensure in Texas as a Professional Counselor.

<u>Position #2</u> – Assistant or Associate Professor in Psychology and Counseling. This position is focused primarily on teaching undergraduate classes in psychology, as well as advising and mentoring Psychology majors. Qualified candidates must have an earned master's degree in Psychology or closely related discipline; earned or in-progress doctoral degrees in a relevant discipline is preferred. - Provide service to both the university and the community.
- Profess a Christian faith, maintain membership in a local congregation, and respect the values and distinctives central to the historically Baptist values of HSU.
